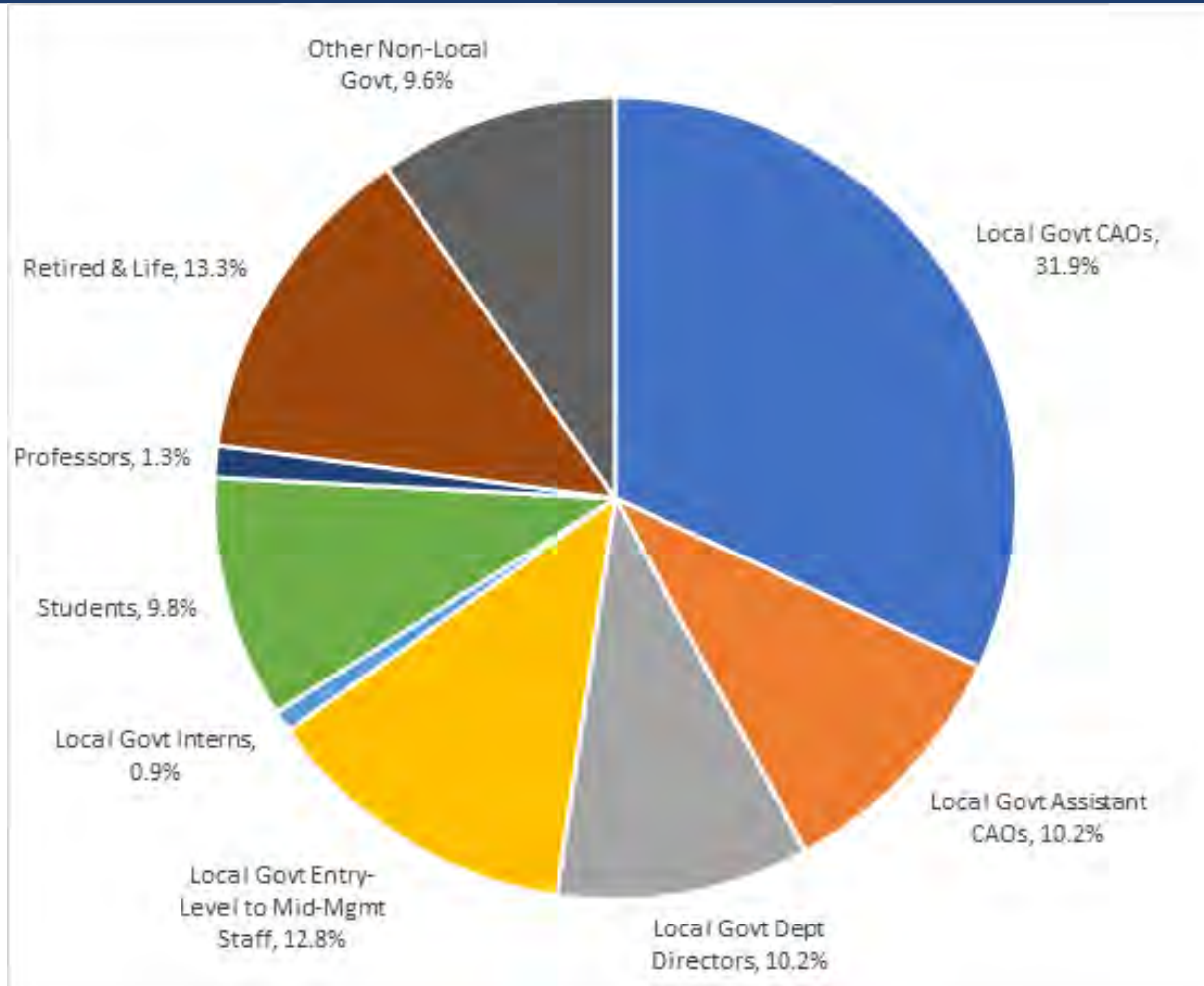

Career Guides

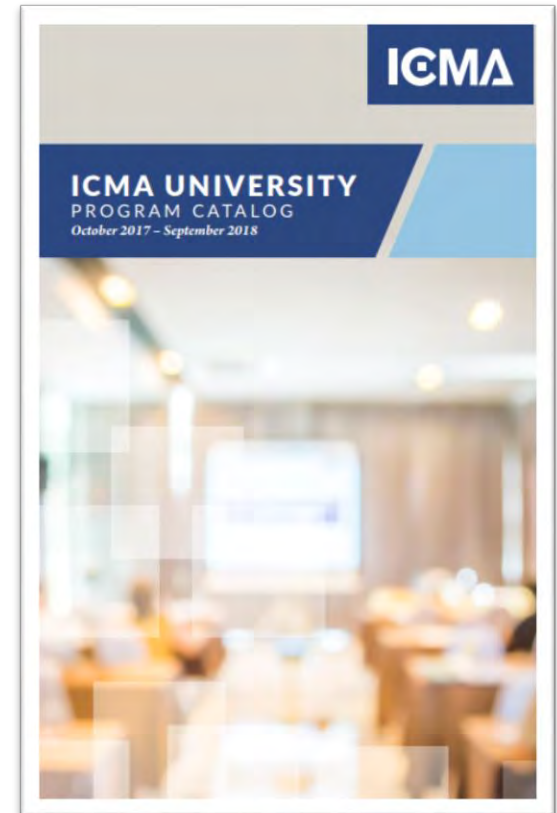

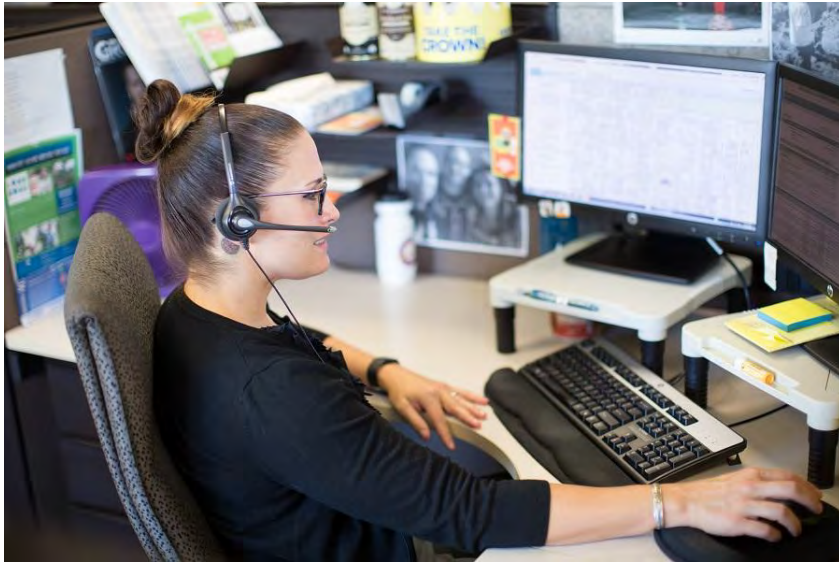

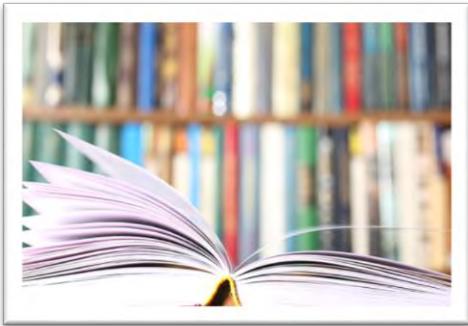
