

Officer Involved Shooting

On April 4, 2022, Patrick Lyoya, a 26-year-old resident of Grand Rapids, was fatally shot by Officer Christopher Schurr of the Grand Rapids Police Department.

Per protocol, investigations of officer involved shootings are performed by a non-involved entity, resulting in the Michigan State Police assuming responsibility. The investigation took several months.

On June 9, 2022, Officer Schurr was charged with second-degree murder. His trial is scheduled to take place next month, in April 2025.
