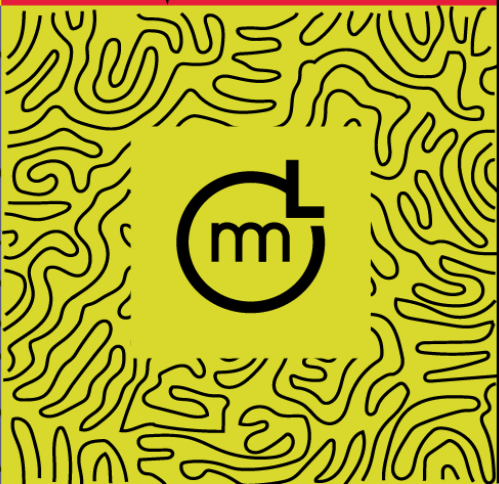
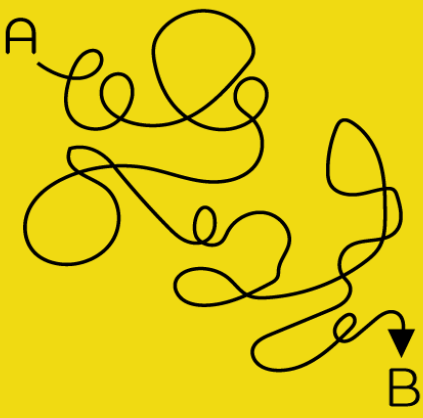

## Example:

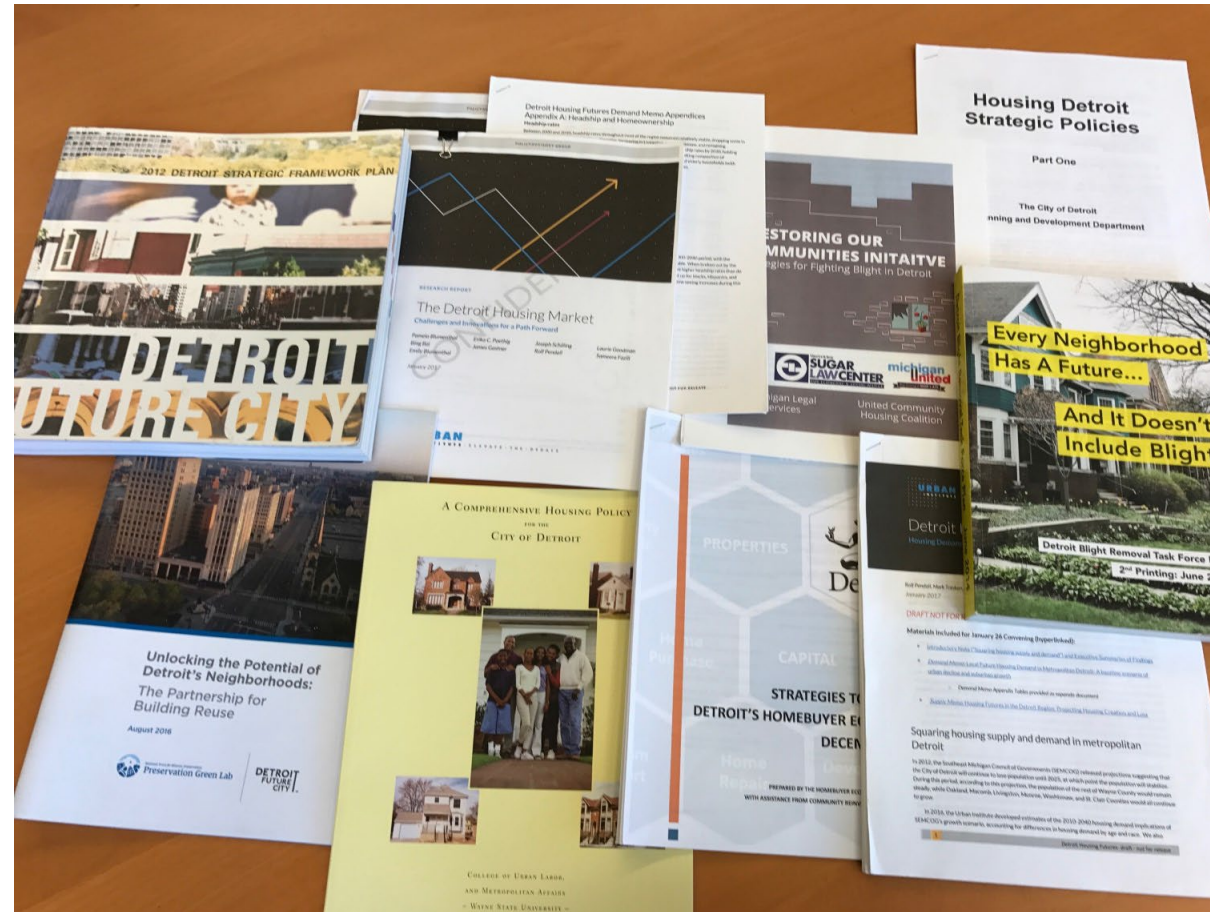
How many nonprofits are in this area?

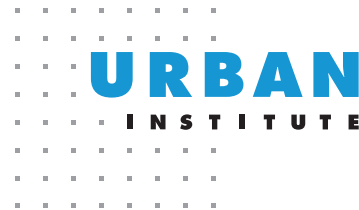

- **Connect to a useful outcome**
- **Do not make human beings duplicate data entry**
- **Regularly review and audit your practices**
- **Make sure that the information will be actionable!**

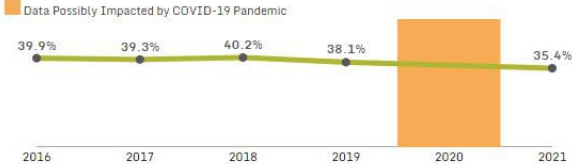

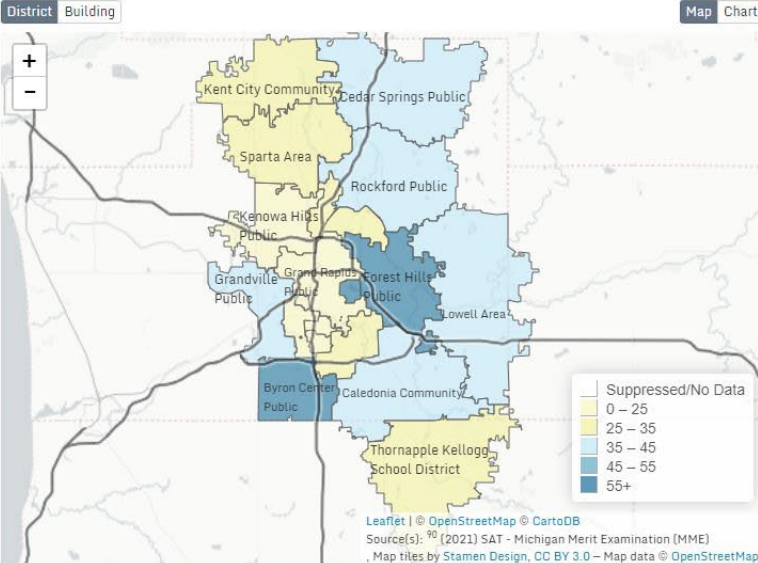
