

## Best Practices in Pavement Preservation

For several years, road agencies have been forced to be innovative, creatively using preventive maintenance treatments as Band-aids to hold pavements together. As the Michigan Legislature and others look at building roads with a service life of more than 50 years, the answers can also be found in preventive maintenance.
